

CHARADES

- Players form two teams
- Players take turns drawing a card
- Try to help your team to guess what is on the card
- You may use actions and gestures but never any sounds
- If your team guesses correctly, you score a point
- The team with the most points wins

MEMORY

PRINT AND CUT OUT TWO COPIES OF THE CARDS

- Mix up the cards and lay them face-down
- Players take turns to turn over any two cards
- If the two cards match, keep the cards
- If the cards don't match, put them back face-down
- Try to remember which cards are where
- The game is over when all the cards have been matched
- The player with the most cards at the end wins







CATCHPHRASE

- Follow the instructions for charades
- This time you can use words and sounds as well as actions and gestures
- You cannot give as a clue
 - The word on the card
 - A word that rhymes with the word on the card
 - The first letter of the word
 - Any part of the word
- The team with the most points wins
